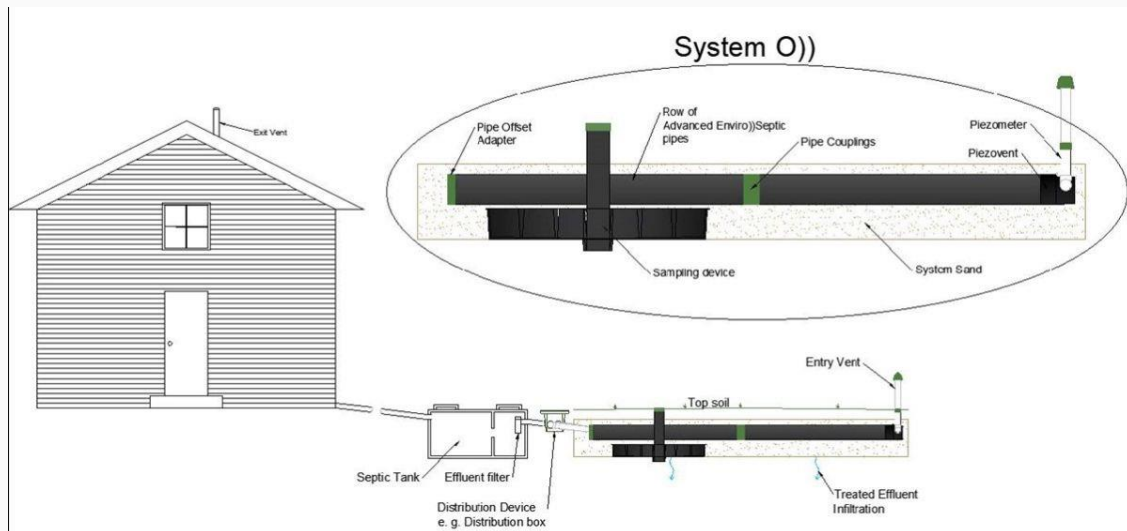


Figure 1: Standard Configuration, BMEC #23-05-407

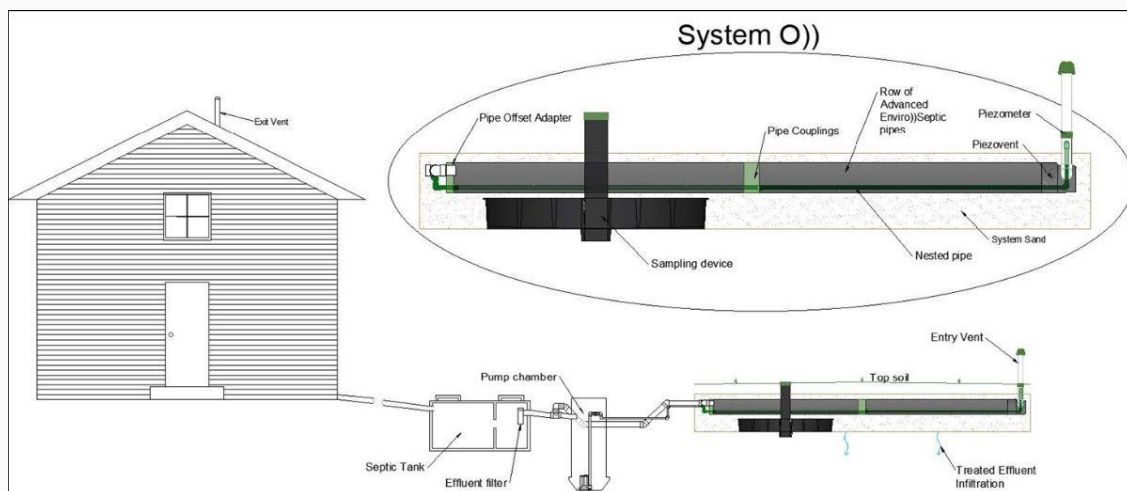


Figure 2: Nested Pipe Configuration, BMEC #23-06-408
